

## Tenure Track Position in Operations & Supply Chain Management

## **Job Description**

The Department of Marketing and Supply Chain Management of East Carolina University (ECU) is a large, vibrant community of teachers and scholars housed within a comprehensive university of 29,000 students. The Department of Marketing and Supply Chain Management is seeking outstanding applicants to apply for an open rank tenure-track, nine-month faculty position in Operations and Supply Chain Management beginning in August 2018. Faculty will have teaching in the area of Operations Management and/or Supply Chain Management at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. Normal teaching load is nine hours. Additional duties include research/creative activities leading to publications in high caliber, peer-reviewed journals; an interest in obtaining external funding; as well as appropriate service to the university, community and profession.

## **Minimum Qualifications:**

Appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor or above requires a PhD in supply chain management, operations management or a related field from an appropriately accredited institution that satisfies credentialing under SACS guidelines. Position requires teaching excellence and strong scholarly productivity.

Candidates with PhD conferred at the time of initial appointment preferred, however, candidates with all degree requirements completed or ABD at the time of initial appointment, with degree conferral no later than December 2018, will be considered for initial appointment at the probationary rank of Assistant Professor according to the university tenure regulations. After conferral of the doctoral degree (December 2018), the appointment rank will become Assistant Professor at the beginning of the spring semester 2019, with no change in timing of reappointment and tenure decisions.

Prefer candidates with background in teaching operations and supply chain topics and Excel and spreadsheet usage as applied to business decision problems.
