- a. Please send a no longer than **50 words abstract** of continuous text (no bullet points, no math or Greek symbols) describing your research to [bsre@sussex.ac.uk](mailto:bsre@sussex.ac.uk) using the [submission template](#). The title should be no longer than 15 words.
- b. One person can present two papers at most.
- c. **The deadline for abstracts submission is 15<sup>th</sup> June 2019.**
