- a. Please send a no longer than 50 words abstract of continuous text (no bullet points, no math or Greek symbols) describing your research to <u>bsre@sussex.ac.uk</u> using the <u>submission template</u>. The title should be no longer than 15 words.
- b. One person can present two papers at most.
- c. The deadline for abstracts submission is 15th June 2019.
- *** Acceptance notifications will be sent on a continuous basis one week after abstract submission, not after the end of the submission deadline! ***
