

INSEAD is now accepting PhD applications for the Technology and Operations Management for September 2020 intake, with a deadline of 06 January 2020.

All PhD applicants admitted to the programme will receive 5 years of full funding from INSEAD, including tuition fee waiver, annual stipend, research and conference budget support, and health insurance coverage.

INSEAD PhD candidates will receive intensive foundations training in their coursework, so that they will have the essential tools to conduct rigorous research. In addition to receiving classroom instruction and discussion, PhD candidates will go through a rigorous teaching preparation programme and research practicum. The INSEAD PhD Programme is highly interdisciplinary, and PhD students are strongly encouraged to collaborate with peers and faculty members across all areas.
