



Tenure-track faculty positions for Assistant and/or Associate Professor in Operations Management

The minimum requirements are for the candidate to have a Ph.D. in Operations Management or a related area by July 1, 2019, and to be highly committed to excellence in research and in teaching graduate and undergraduate students. A competitive salary will be offered, with an expected teaching load of three (3-credit hours each) courses per year.

The OM faculty at Scheller is committed to high quality research in areas including business analytics, global supply chain management, knowledge management, management of technology, new product and process development, operations strategy, revenue management, and sustainable operations. Our research interests and expertise span across both analytical and empirical methodologies. The OM area has an active doctoral program with a strong placement record.
