Applicants for senior appointments should have published extensively in top-tier refereed journals and have a proven track record of successfully mentoring junior faculty. As an institution aspiring to be counted among the top 10 in the world, ISB offers a unique opportunity for its senior faculty members to exert considerable influence over the culture and ethos of the school.

The ISB is a not for profit, independent, research-driven, global business school with two campuses located in Hyderabad and Mohali, India. A collaborative effort of eminent business leaders, entrepreneurs, and academicians from around the world laid the foundation for the school.

The ISB launched its one year Post Graduate Programme in Management (PGP), equivalent to the two-year MBA Courses offered by premier Business Schools in India, in 2001.
