Applicants are expected to teach in the area of business analytics or operations management (broadly defined) at the undergraduate and graduate/MBA levels. There will be opportunities to be involved in the NUS Masters of Science in Business Analytics program.

The Department of Analytics and Operations has more than 20 faculty members in the areas of operations research, operations management, logistics/supply chain management, and information systems/technology. The department has a strong and vibrant research environment. It co-hosts NUS Business Analytics Center jointly with the School of Computing, and it is actively involved in the Institute for Operations Research and Analytics (IORA), a cross-faculty research institute that offers a multidisciplinary Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) program.
