Position

Qualifications

Responsibilities

The lecturer is assigned an instructional workload of 24 credits per academic year (fall and spring semesters). Depending on the needs of the department, assigned courses may include problem solving in business, business analytics, and other courses.

Undergraduate advising is part of teaching responsibilities. Service to the department, college, and university is expected. The successful candidate must have the ability to work with a diverse student population and teach effectively in the subject areas.
