

The Culverhouse College of Commerce at The University of Alabama invites applications for **two faculty positions** in Applied Statistics, at the Associate or Full Professor level, with an expected start date of August 16, 2018. Candidates must hold a Ph.D. in Statistics, or a closely related field. Successful candidates will be expected to lead independent and rigorous research in statistics with an emphasis on Data Science or Network Analytics. Preferred candidates will also have interdisciplinary research interests in at least one of the following application areas: energy, water, environment, lifespan, healthcare, cybersecurity, or transportation. Applicants with a track record of externally funded research are strongly preferred.

Salary is very competitive and commensurate with experience and achievements. Applicants must apply online at <https://facultyjobs.ua.edu/postings/41281> and include a one-page cover letter, curriculum vitae, research statement, one or two representative research papers, and a list of at least three references with contact information. Required documents not attached at the time of application will disqualify application. Prior to hiring, the candidate must successfully pass a pre-employment background investigation.
