Tenure-Track Assistant Professor of Business Analytics

The Madden School of Business at Le Moyne College is seeking to fill a tenure-track assistant professor position in its business analytics program to begin in the fall 2016 semester. The program has experienced rapid growth over the past five years. Twenty-five percent of the current senior class will graduate with a business analytics major.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach undergraduate and graduate business analytics courses. All business analytics courses are taught in a computer lab, which creates an active learning environment where students obtain hands-on experience working together with their professors and classmates on analytics-related problems using large data sets. In addition to the teaching responsibilities, the successful candidate will be expected to maintain an active research agenda resulting in journal publications and to participate in service activities. The candidate should possess an earned Ph.D. in an area closely related to business analytics (e.g., operations research, management science, operations management, supply chain management, and decision science) by the start of the appointment. We are also interested in candidates whose doctoral training is in a related area such as computational finance, marketing modeling, statistics, and engineering.
