Scope

The IJCIEOM ´23 is going to be held in Lusófona University, Lisbon, Portugal, from 28 - 30 June 2023. This conference is in its 29th edition and aims to promote networking among researchers to exchange ideas and approaches, present advances in industrial engineering and operations management and provide an excellent opportunity to publish scientific papers in indexed journals.

We are pleased to invite you to submit your papers or extended abstract to IJCIEOM ´'23. All submissions will peer-review based on relevance, originality and importance to the Industrial Engineering and Operations Management.

The submitted papers should be related to operations, manufacturing, industrial and production engineering and management fields. Specific themes include, but are not limited to:

Types of Submissions

Full paper: Consolidated research works. If approved, these papers are going to be published and indexed to Scopus. There is a 12-pages limit.

Extended Abstracts: Ongoing works with relevant preliminary results, open to discussion. These papers are assigned a 2-page limit.

Submitted papers must comply with the format of Springer Proceedings in Mathematics & Statistics, be written in English and must not be under review in any other conference or journal, nor have they been previously published. Articles submitted in the first phase will follow a blind peer review process. Author names and affiliations should not be included in the review version. This information must be included only in the camera-ready version (second phase) for the accepted papers. The revised version in Word and the completed consent form for publication must be uploaded to the platform.

Based on the Scientific Committee's evaluation, an article can be rejected or accepted. If the full paper is accepted, it will have the opportunity to be published in Springer Proceedings. Additionally, selected articles may be published in Fast Tracks or Special Issue of Journals. In this case, the authors will have to significantly expand their article

(up to 80%) in order to be submitted to a new review process in the Journal.

Likewise, extended abstracts may be accepted only for discussion and presentation at the conference. Its publication will be made in non-indexed conference proceedings.

Authors of accepted full papers and extended abstracts will have 10 minutes to present their work in a Conference Work Session; approximately 5 minutes of discussion will follow each presentation.

Publication and Indexing

To ensure publication and presentation of a full paper or extended abstract, at least one of the authors must be registered by May 20, 2023, and the paper must comply with the suggested layout and page limit. Additionally, all recommended changes must be addressed by authors before they submit the camera-ready version. An extra fee must be paid for publishing additional articles, with a maximum of two additional articles per submission. One registration allows only one author to participate in the conference.

Full papers will be published in Springer Proceedings in Mathematics & Statistics.

Published full papers will be submitted for indexation by Scopus, DBLP, Google Scholar, among others, and will be available in the SpringerLink Digital Library.

The authors of the best selected papers will be invited to extend them for publication in international journals indexed by WoS/SCI, SCOPUS, among others, such as:

The 29th IJCIEOM will award two prizes for the best paper: 1) Prof. David Clay Whybark Award is aimed at senior researchers who have excelled in the field of industrial engineering and operations management - this award is for the best article in which the first author is a senior researcher; and 2) the student award will be given to the best work in which the first author is developing his doctoral thesis or master's dissertation.
