Tenure-track Assistant Professor of Operations & Supply Chain Management

- Position:** **Tenure-track Assistant Professor of Operations & Supply Chain Management**, beginning August 2017. Salary is AACSB competitive. Hiring is contingent on maintaining existing levels of funding from the state.
- Responsibilities:** Maintain an active and high-quality research agenda. Teach courses in Supply Chain Management and related areas at graduate and undergraduate levels, including work with doctoral students. Participate in departmental, college, and university service.
- Qualifications:** Minimum Qualifications: Earned doctorate in Operations and Supply Chain Management or related field (ABD candidates considered, but hired as instructors and the doctoral degree must be completed by June 30, 2018); evidence of high-quality research and teaching potential; ability to teach both undergraduate and graduate supply chain management courses; good oral and written communication skills.
- Preferred Qualifications: Active research record, including recent publications; documented excellence in teaching; prior relevant industry experience and the ability to contribute through teaching and/or service to the diversity, cultural sensitivity, and excellence of the academic community.
