1. The Sessions

2. The Schedule

The session is usually scheduled on the first day of the conference at slot B. Student poster exhibition starts at 10:00am at the session room; all are welcomed to arrive earlier to interact with the students. The Introduction and Interaction session formally starts at 11:00am. The student poster exhibition continuous until 1:00pm.
